



## Call the midwife or GP

## if you have any of the following...



Spotting or bleeding

Sharp or continuing abdominal pain



Vomiting all or most food



Leaking fluid from the vagina



Persistent severe headache



Swelling in face, hands or legs



Cramps in your lower back or



Itching, especially

on hands and feet



Painful urination

## pelvic area



Vagnal bleeding and abdominal pain could mean a miscarriage. If you have these symptoms without a confirmed pregnancy or in early pregnancy without a midwife talk to your GP or Early Pregnancy Unit.



If your symptoms are severe, or if you have noticed any change or reduction in your baby's movements in the womb, contact the labour ward immediately
